USGA rules govern all play, except where modified by the following local rules.

1. Out of Bounds: Defined by white stakes or lines.
2. Hole No. 5: (USGA Decision 33-8/13) If ball strikes a power line at the 5th hole, the player must disregard that stroke, abandon the ball and play another ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played in accordance with Rule 20-5 (Playing Next Stroke from Where Previous Stroke Played).
3. Hole No. 10: A ball drop area has been provided on the 10th hole. The ball drop area, located beyond the forward teeing area maybe used if your ball goes into the water hazard. One stroke penalty.
4. Flower Beds: If a ball lies in a flower bed or area of ornamental planting, or if flowers or ornamental planting interfere with a player's stance or area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b (Immovable Obstruction).
5. Distance Measuring Devices: are permitted under USGA Local Rule Appendix I.
